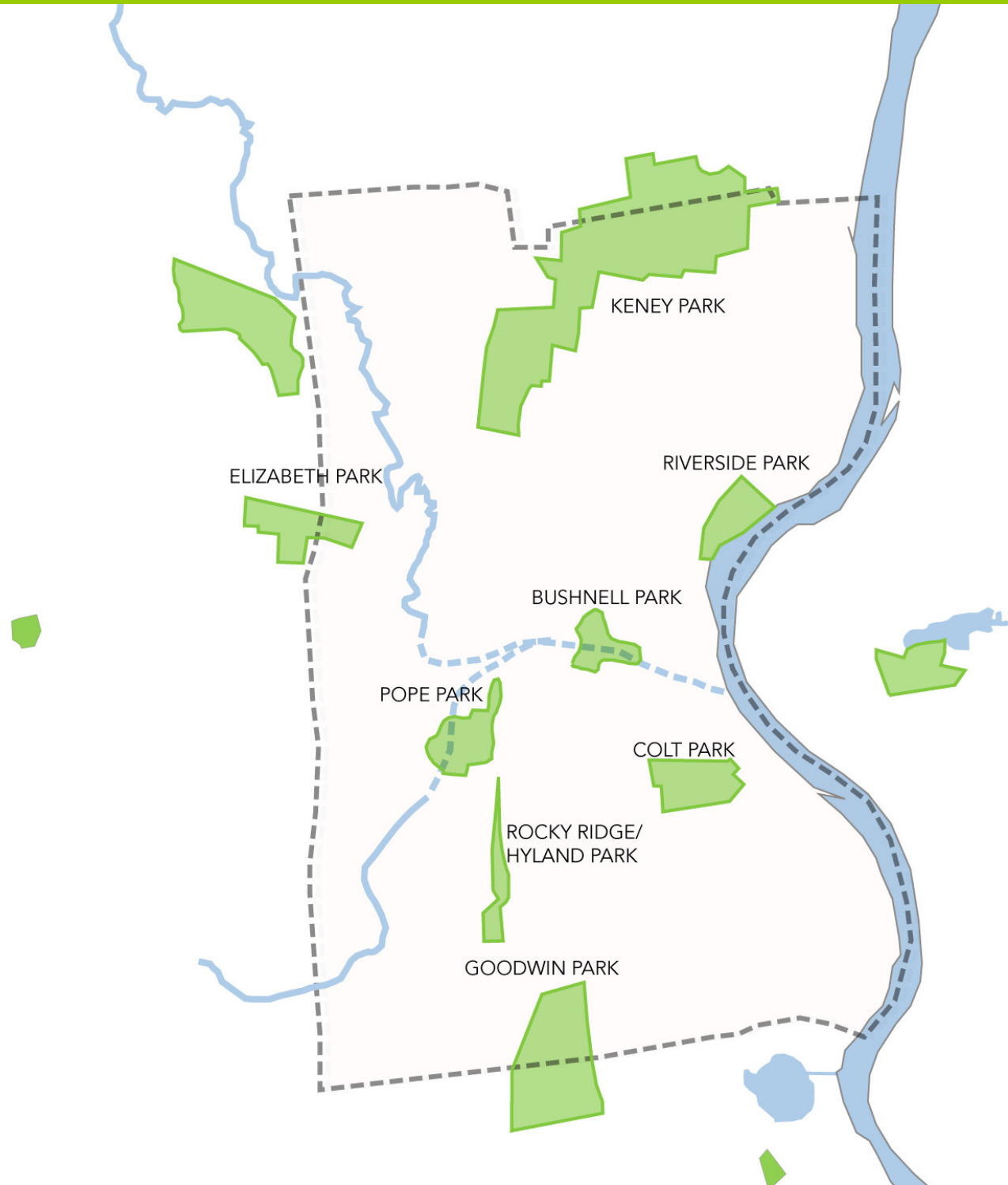
PARKS AND TRAILS

Wethersfield Avenue

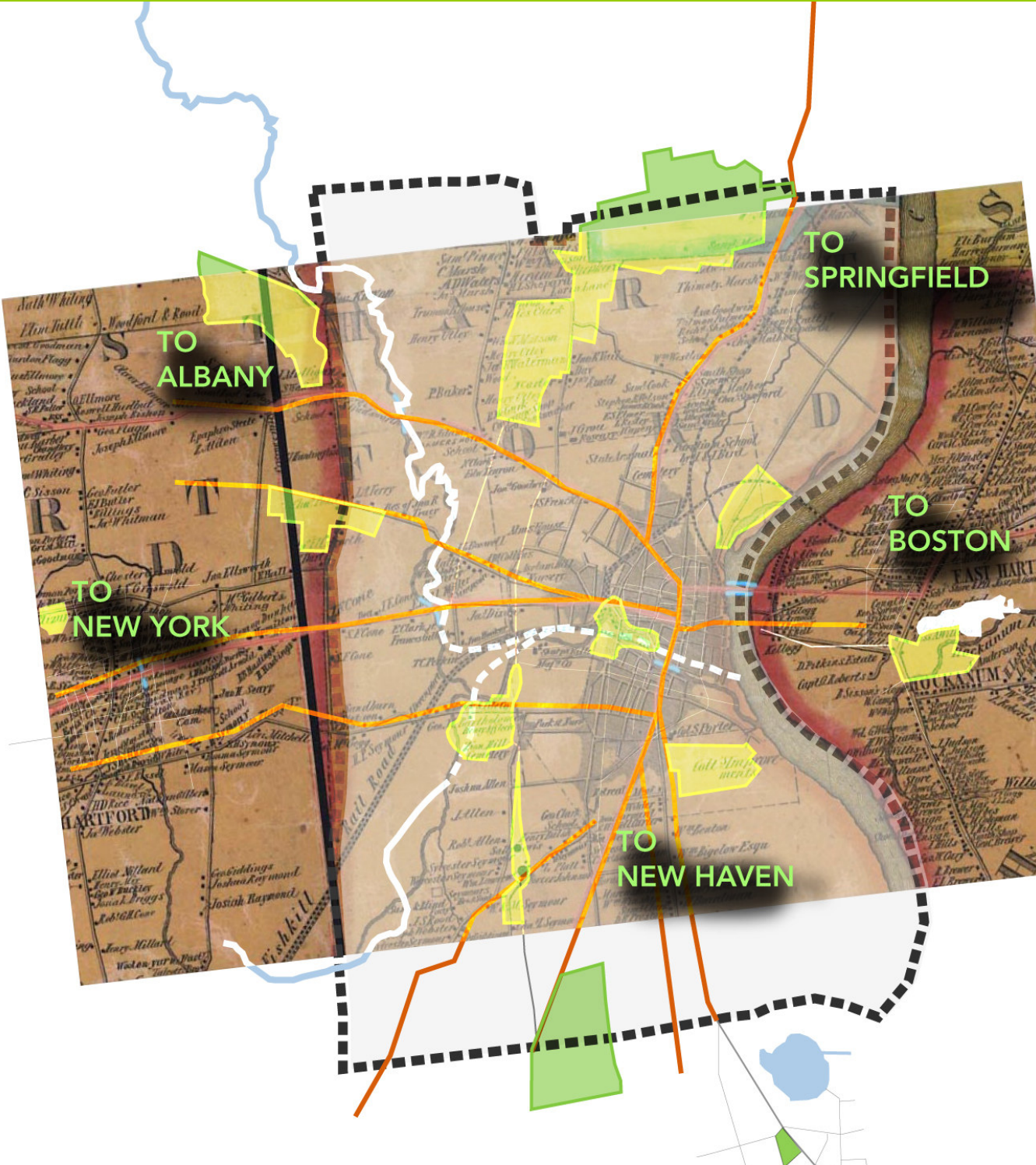
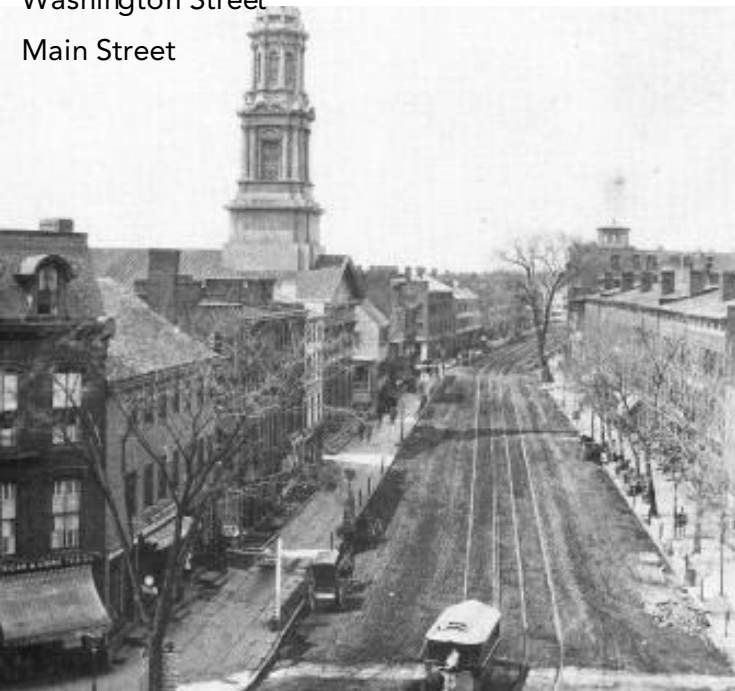

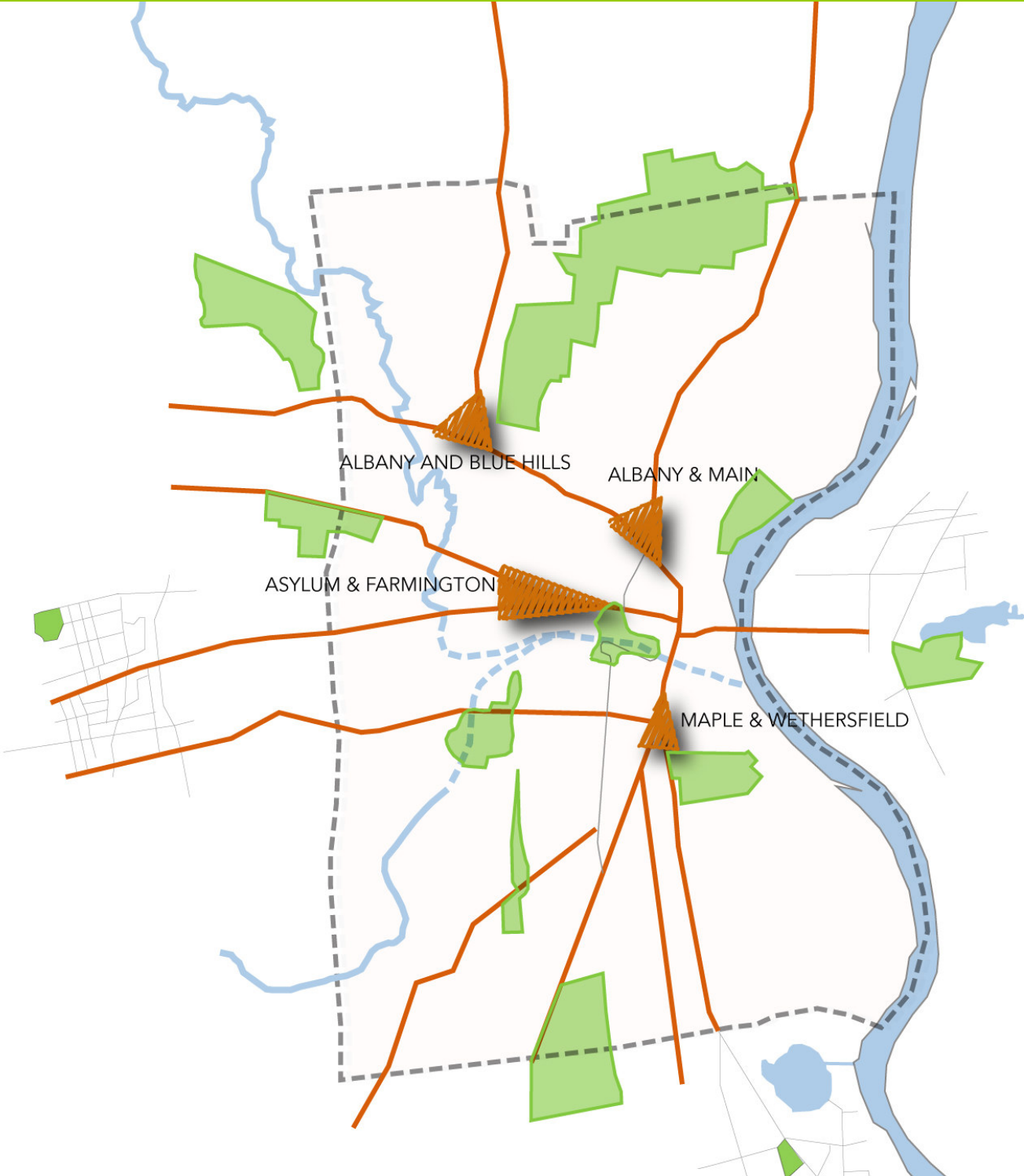
STARTING POINTS
