

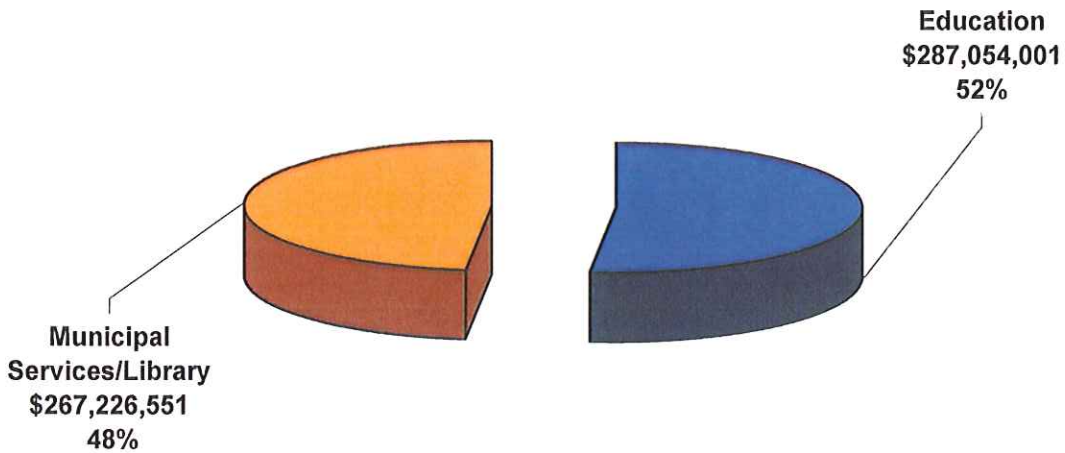

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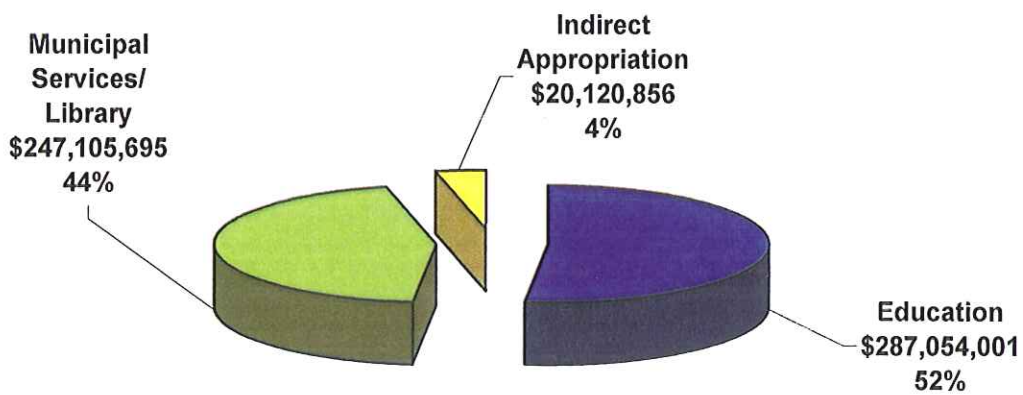
*Education Expenditures as a Percent of the Total General Fund Expenditures (\$554,280,552)*

**Mission Statement:**

Hartford's System of Schools exists to provide all of its students with access to participation in the global economy, through attainment of the Academic Standards of the State of Connecticut, as well as readiness for post-secondary education.

**Significant Features:**

The Recommended Budget for Fiscal Year 2010-2011 is \$287,054,001. This reflects an increase of \$2,500,000 or 0.9% from the 2009-2010 Adopted Budget. The Board of Education is projecting to eliminate an additional 92.1 positions for fiscal year 2010-11. Continuing as part of the Recommended Budget, the fringe benefits costs are incorporated as part of the direct appropriation budget.

The Hartford Public School System receives funding from other sources that include federal grants, state grants, foundations, private sources, as well as other donations and contributions. This funding is categorized as the Special Funds Budget. The 2010-2011 Special Funds Budget projected amount totals \$95,615,121. This reflects a decrease of \$15,473,174 or 13.9% from the 2009-10 BOE Adopted Special Funds of \$111,088,295.

The Indirect Municipal Contribution for the Board of Education is \$20,120,856. This cost is attributed to principal and interest payments in the amount of \$15,620,856 for bond maturities and other obligations for the construction and renovation of various schools. The balance of \$4,500,000 is related to the projected \*In-Kind Services (ED-001) the Municipality provides the Hartford Public School System throughout the fiscal year.

Therefore, the combined budget for the Hartford Public School System would total \$402,789,978.
